## The CHUM, a hospital where patients can expect the state of the art

With its incredible expertise, unique innovations and welcoming and caring environment, the CHUM provides Quebec's patients with the most advanced specialized and subspecialized care possible.

As a university hospital affiliated with Université de Montréal, the CHUM is devoted to research, teaching and taking stock of care, new technologies and intervention methods in health.

## Our philanthropic priority areas

The CHUM is taking on some of the biggest issues in health right now. In many fields, traditional medicine has reached its limits. Empowered by your donations, the CHUM's teams are taking these challenges as an opportunity to fight disease:

### Cancer

*The #1 cause of death in Canada.*

At a time when the number of cancer cases is rising every year, the CHUM's teams are developing the oncology solutions of the future. From oncolytic vaccines to immunocellular therapy, the CHUM's professionals are working tirelessly to provide their patients with treatments that are more innovative, more personalized and less invasive.

### Cardiometabolic diseases

*1 in 3 people has a cardiometabolic disease.*

Cardiovascular diseases associated with a metabolic disease (diabetes or obesity) are one of the main causes of reduced life expectancy in North America, and the CHUM's researchers are doing everything in their power to prevent these diseases and provide better treatment.

### Immunopathology

*Over 62,000 people in Canada are living with HIV.*

Immunopathology plays a key role in helping us understand immune system-related diseases, including chronic viral illnesses such as HIV and Hepatitis C. Globally renowned researchers are working hard in the CHUM's state-of-the-art facilities to identify the factors that lead these infections to progress, so that we can better prevent and treat them—and maybe even eradicate them.

### Mental health

*1 in 3 people will experience a mental illness in their lifetime.*

The long-term effects of the pandemic are exacerbating an already alarming trend in mental health. Research at the CHUM focuses on how to identify behavioural risk factors and new treatment targets that will help people with mental health issues get earlier diagnoses and more effective solutions for improving their psychological health.

### Neuroscience

*By 2030, the number of people living with a neurological disease will have doubled.*

As the population ages, certain neurological disorders, such as Alzheimer's or Parkinson's, are on the rise. The CHUM's teams analyse clinical and genomic data and use artificial intelligence to give themselves what they need to act earlier and more effectively.





# What your generous donations make possible

Your donations fund innovative, bold projects carried out by the CHUM's teams. By supporting our foundation, you're helping the medical community act faster than disease by driving research, revolutionizing care and transforming the health curriculum.

## Care

### Incision-free robotic operating technology

Led by Dr. Moishe Liberman and his team, the Robotic Center of Excellence (CER) strives to support physicians with operations, make surgeries less invasive and cut down recovery times. Thanks to you, we were able to raise \$2 million to purchase a next-generation da Vinci, a robotic-assisted platform that lets physicians perform precision surgery in tight spaces without needing to make major incisions. Thanks to the CHUM, the CER and your donations, this procedure is now practiced throughout the entire world.

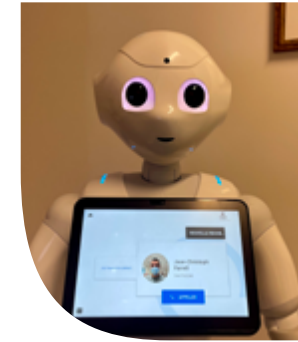
### Addressing youth accessibility challenges in mental health services

The "ECHO® CHUM Troubles Concomitant" telementoring program brings together over 200 CHUM mental health specialists, numerous partners and interdisciplinary teams that work with youth aged 15 to 29 who are struggling with psychological and psychiatric disorders. This project, made possible thanks to a generous contribution from RBC, has a simple goal: providing better treatment for mental health issues and reducing their impacts on patients' lives through an interactive platform where health professionals can share their knowledge and expertise, so that even more specialists can be trained.



*"We can now decentralize care and expand access by offering this program to the entire health and social services system, as well as the community sector. We can develop training methods and material that are tailored to youth intervention and users' specific needs. ### Luca, a robot that's humanizing cares

Luca is the CHUM's humanoid robot who humanizes care. Funded by a contribution from Metro Supply Chain and named in honour of its president's son, Luca is another arrow in the quiver for the CHUM's teams as they strive to make their patients better.



### Equalizing access to oral care

It is essential for critically ill patients to have good oral health before they start a treatment or undergo surgery. Despite this, oral health costs are not covered by the RAMQ, with potentially serious impacts for a patient's condition when oral health care is ignored for financial reasons. Now, the CHUM is able to offer oral health procedures for free thanks to our foundation's financial support and a \$40,000 donation from Œuvres Régis-Vernet.

### A revolutionary technology for treating epilepsy

Dr. Alain Bouthillier, Dr. Alexander Weil and Dr. Sami Obaid successfully carried out the first minimally invasive surgical procedures for treating people with epilepsy. Thanks to your donations, we raised \$379,076 to help fund a state-of-the-art neurosurgical laser, the NeuroBlate®. The laser allows physicians to access areas of the brain that are usually inaccessible through traditional surgery. This reduces hospitalization times and can help prevent all kinds of neurological damage.





## Research



### What if we could treat breast cancer with vaccines?

Laboratory studies carried out by Dr. Marie-Claude Bourgeois-Daigneault and her team show that breast cancer can be eradicated through the injection of an oncolytic virus, created from scratch in a lab. The virus attacks the tumour and makes it possible for the immune system to recognize and destroy the cancer in the case of a recurrence. Thanks to the generous bequest of the late Andrée Despins and a contribution from her husband, Guy Breton, this research can continue so we can see whether it can be effective in humans.



*"I have faith in the incredible potential of treating breast cancer with oncolytic viruses, as I have seen cancerous tumours entirely disappear from multiple mice after they were vaccinated. Thanks to this bequest, we will be able to unlock some of the mysteries of the immune system so that we can effectively apply the treatment to humans."*

### On a course to precision medicine with COMET

Scientific breakthroughs come from bold initiatives and research expertise, but they can be accelerated with the use of cutting-edge equipment. Through your generosity, we were able to provide \$500,000 in funding for COMET, a revolutionary device used in astrobiology that can precisely identify and analyze the markers of cellular, molecular and chemical change in our body. Learning more about these patterns will pave the way for the development of new diagnostic and treatment tools for providing more tailored and personalized care in numerous medical specialties.



Newsweek named the CHUM the **#1 hospital in Quebec** and **#2 in Canada** for cutting-edge technology.



### Supporting inspiring projects and attracting the brightest professionals

For the CHUM and its research centre, hiring the best talent in healthcare is fundamental. Attractive working conditions help the CHUM entice and retain the world's best and brightest in healthcare in order to achieve the audacious goals they've set for themselves. This year, our foundation supported these efforts by distributing **over \$2,998,112** in start-up, research and fellowship grants to physicians and researchers whose transformative projects for patients and the caring community truly stand out.

## Quebecor receives the *Prix coup de cœur philanthropique*

June 8, 2022, was the CHUM's first ever "*Lumière sur les équipes*". After careful deliberation, a jury selected Quebecor as an exceptional supporter of our Foundation's mission, awarding them the "*Prix coup de cœur philanthropique*".

With its historic \$15 million contribution, Quebecor made the final phase of the CHUM's construction possible. During the pandemic, the company demonstrated its extraordinary generosity and civic responsibility by giving the CHUM's care teams 150 mobile devices that let them stay in contact with their patients while minimizing the risks of infection.

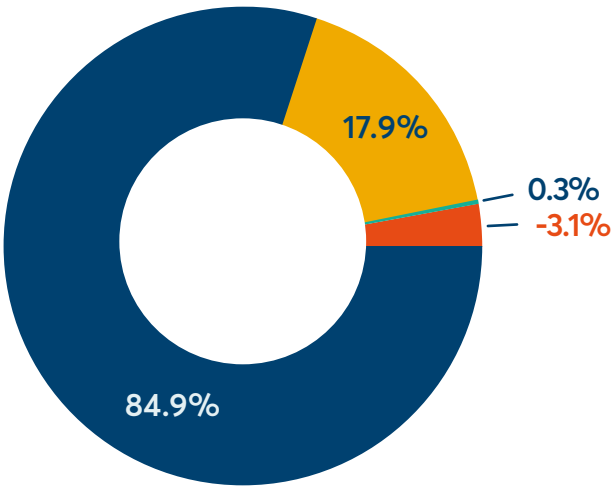
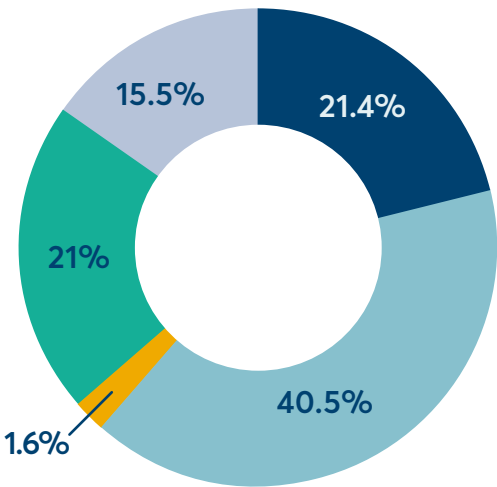
