A transformational legacy gift: \$32 million to drive precision medicine

- Better disease prevention
- Faster, more accurate diagnostics

This bequest will be a powerful tool for change, positioning CHUM teams to receive major grants and be better equipped to pursue their research.



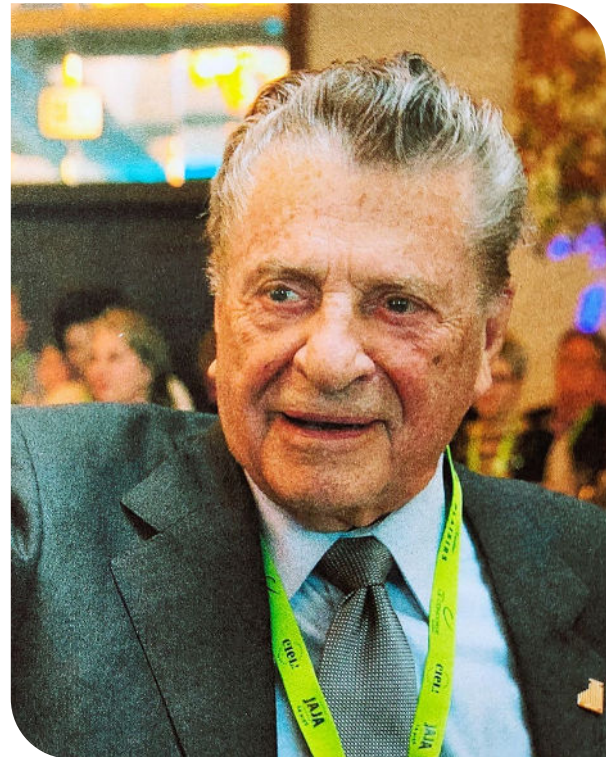
This major donation is part of **Paul Durocher's extraordinary legacy gift of nearly \$150 million** to four Montréal foundations: the CHUM Foundation, Montreal Heart Institute Foundation, the St. Mary's Hospital Foundation and the Société de Saint-Vincent de Paul de Montréal.

About Paul Durocher

Born in Montréal in 1929, Paul Durocher grew up as one of nine children in a family of modest means during the Great Depression. He first trained as a mechanic before going on to found numerous businesses in a wide range of industries. He went from rags to riches, all the while donating to a number of causes, often anonymously, throughout his life.

In the twilight of his life, Paul Durocher sold off a large portion of his assets, took the proceeds and grew them to maximize his bequest to the four foundations. His support will be the foundation for numerous projects that will shape the future of healthcare and improve the lives of so many patients.

Paul Durocher was always driven to help those most vulnerable in our society. He was a humble and discreet man. He wasn't looking for praise, but we simply cannot let his extraordinary generosity—or his extraordinary life, driven by a deep commitment to community—go overlooked.

On November 27, 2024, a special event was held to honour Paul Durocher's historic gift. Attendees learned about the CHUM's Precision Medicine Strategy, as well as Paul Durocher's incredible life, thanks to a touching speech from his nephew Claude St-Jean.

This emotional event served also to announce the renaming of the CHUM's Viger East Street entrance, now the Paul-Durocher entrance, in tribute to his remarkable contribution.

Palliative care unit

\$240,000 over 3 years

Proposing a wide range of care amenities—**music therapy, art therapy, massage therapy, hair care and TV screens for all 10 rooms**—in addition to the medical care that brings peace and comfort to the patients in the palliative care unit.

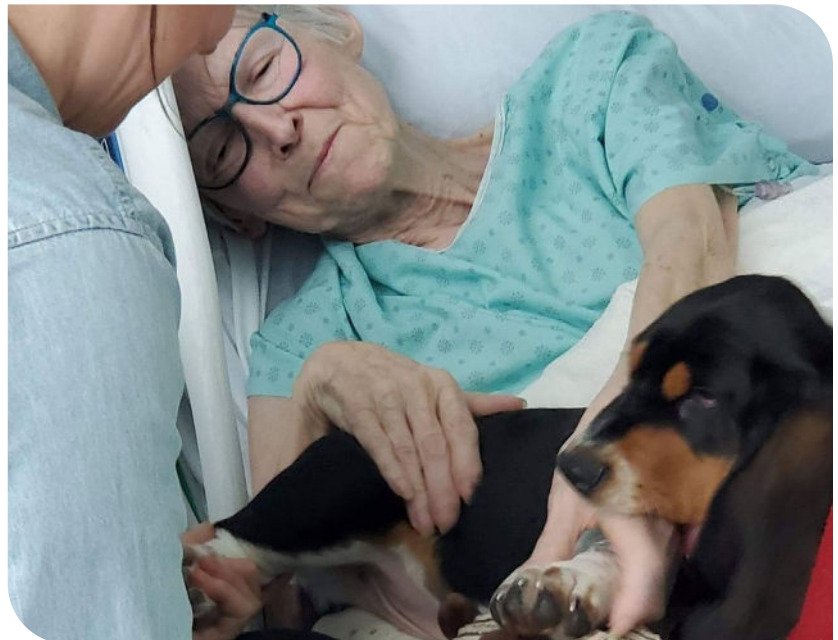

Staying connected with loved ones, even in hospital

\$150,000

Purchasing **100 iPads** (and accessories) to give patients hospitalized at the CHUM a way to entertain themselves and, more importantly, stay in touch with loved ones, during times when connection with friends and family, even through a screen, can make a world of difference.

Centre de gestion de la douleur

\$25,000

Incorporating wellness and self-expression into the care journey, through **chair-based gymnastics, yoga and creative workshops**.

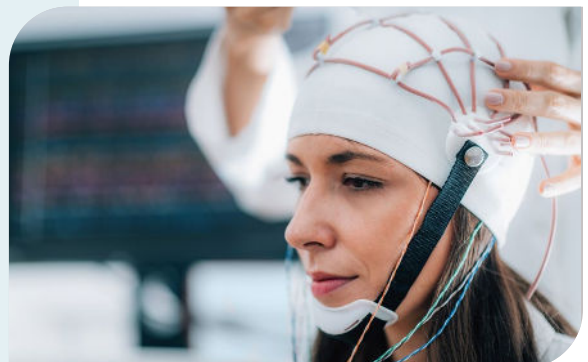

State-of-the-art equipment

\$200,000

Giving patients struggling with treatment-resistant chronic pain a new option for care with a **transcranial stimulation device**. This type of non-invasive treatment will be offered as part of the Clinique de gestion de la douleur’s continuum of care and may allow some patients to avoid undergoing more invasive surgeries.



\$116,000

Acquiring **three ultrasound devices** to visualize veins in real time.

Your donations are making it possible for CHUM nurses to use ultrasound devices to more easily and accurately insert catheters for IV treatments. This purchase will make catheterization more effective and is part of an innovative initiative to reduce treatment wait times, prevent complications like infections and thrombosis, and improve care quality and safety—all while optimizing costs and resources.

\$47,560

Revolutionizing cardiac health monitoring and research in women at the Cardio F clinic using **Coroventis CoroFlow**, an advanced cardiovascular system that provides more detailed diagnostics.

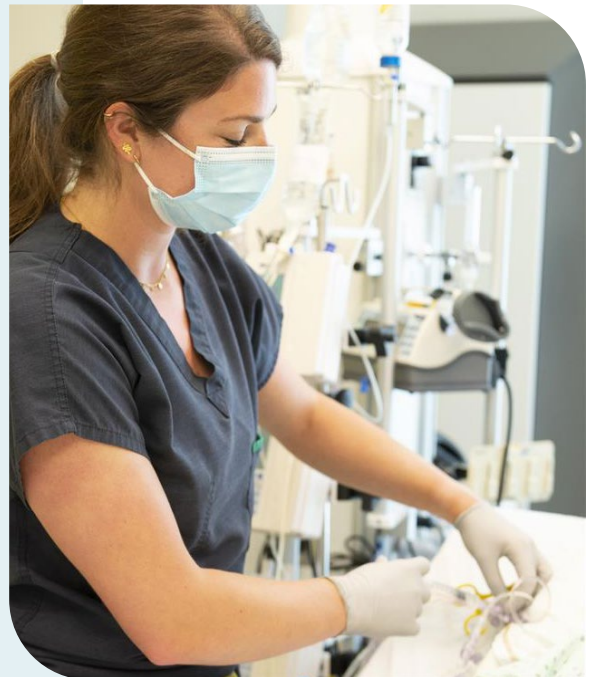
The CHUM will be one of the few centres in the province with this equipment, a gamechanger for both research and care.

\$40,000

More effectively planning liver surgeries using the **Synapse 3D** software. This medical imaging analysis technology virtually reconstructs patients' organs in 3D and accurately calculates volume measurements. The result? More accurate surgeries that are safer for patients.

\$7,000

Increasing patient comfort at the psychiatric neuromodulation clinic, where an **ergonomic TRIAD treatment** chair now helps patients relax during long sessions.



Top-tier research

Moving science forward by recruiting the best and brightest

An extraordinary **\$8,750,000 donation from the Courtois Foundation** will enable the CHUM Research Centre to increase its appeal and jumpstart the most promising ideas, by making it possible to:

- Enable high-level researchers to restart their research activities without delay via expanded, more competitive start-up funds
- Grant competitive start-up funds in fundamental research and other research sectors to early career researchers
- Create a grant program that will help attract the best post-doctoral fellows

This inspiring gesture will give the CRCHUM the ability to boost its critical mass of scientists and the volume of basic research produced and translated into the clinical phase and practice. It will also expand the number of medical breakthroughs and bolster the widespread impact of scientific advances.

By providing an attractive research environment and showcasing Quebec innovation, the CRCHUM will strengthen its position as a leader with the top talent of today and tomorrow.



Thanks to your support of the CHUM's research centre, the CHUM snagged a spot on **Research Infosource's 2024 list of Canada's Top 40 Research Hospitals**, ranking 10th nationally and 2nd in Quebec.





Guy Lafleur Fund: \$1 million for precision oncology

Four research teams led by Dr. Bertrand Routy, Dr. Simon Turcotte, Dr. Isabelle Bourdeau and Dr. Arielle Elkrief each received **\$250,000** in funding for their precision oncology projects. These grants are made possible by your donations to the Guy Lafleur Fund and by a \$500,000 contribution from the Institut du cancer de Montréal.

“Precision oncology tailors treatments to the genetic and molecular characteristics of each patient and their cancer. Already we’ve been able to offer more targeted, effective therapies that are better tolerated by patients and that increase the likelihood of success. But that’s just the start: these therapies have an immense potential to transform cancer treatment that has largely gone unexplored.”

\$1,717,725 over 5 years

Bringing cutting-edge imaging technology and AI to the CHUM to help patients with type 2 diabetes: **ImagingT2D**.

This new tool will allow specialists to more accurately observe how type 2 diabetes—an insidious, complicated disease—affects organ function.

This work is led by the ImagingT2D consortium, a collaboration between the CHUM, the CHU de Sherbrooke and renowned Dutch laboratories, and will pave the way for faster detection of type 2 diabetes complications and better targeted interventions.

Preventing depression by studying brain cells

Ciaran Murphy-Royal's lab was awarded **\$174,000** to study the influence of stress on astrocytes, nonneuronal cells that are essential to healthy brain function.

Murphy-Royal is interested in preventing mental health issues like depression and wants to understand how antidepressants act on astrocytes. His work could potentially help make these medicines more effective.

Multiple sclerosis: Working with intestinal microbiota to curb inflammation

Dr. Catherine Larochelle's research project received **\$25,000** of your support this year to work on developing a targeted, nutrition-based approach for patients with multiple sclerosis.

Dr. Larochelle's team is examining how restricting methionine—an amino acid found in high levels in Western diets—affects intestinal bacteria and immune markers in healthy patients to confirm whether it is possible to mitigate inflammation in humans through dietary changes.



Cutting-edge teaching

\$155,000

Contributing to the CHUM's **professional development and fellowship grant program**.

This program is funded through a one-of-a-kind collaboration between the CHUM Conseil des médecins, dentistes et pharmaciens (CMDP), the Foundation and various CHUM departments involved in the program. It aims to help the next generation of healthcare professionals gain cutting-edge skills and advanced expertise. The program also helps the CHUM recruit the very best professionals so its patients can receive the very best care.

\$150,000 over 3 years

Funding a **new respiratory therapy grant program** to attract the best and brightest to the CHUM.

\$40,000

Enhancing **training and professional development of fellows in emergency medicine**.

\$19,390

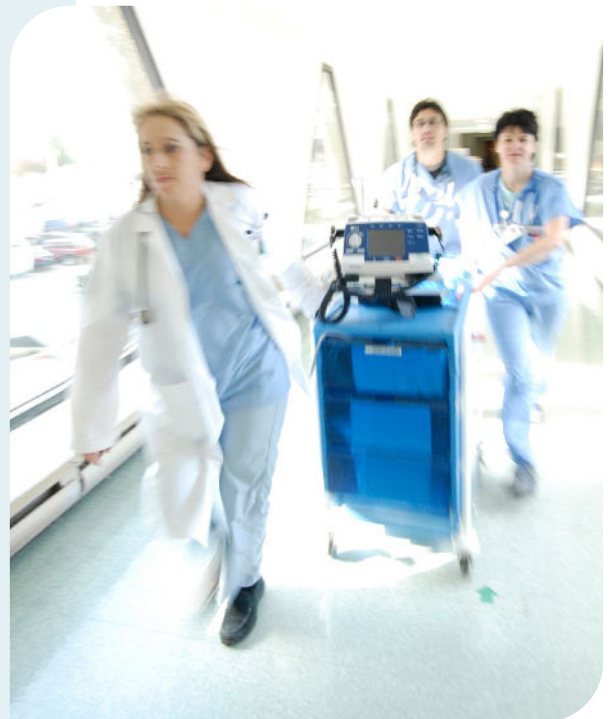
Providing cardiology residents with an **immersive, simulation-based training** to prepare them for the real-world clinical issues they will face.

\$6,672

Supporting training for nurses working with cancer patients through a specialized seminar from the **Quebec Chapter of the Canadian Association of Nurses in Oncology**.

Enabling CHUM teams to **educate new moms about mental health issues** and offer them tools to better equip them to deal.



From vision to action: First results of a major contribution

Last year, we shared that the Foundation would be giving **\$1,450,000** to the Direction de l'enseignement et de l'Académie du CHUM (DEAC) over three years.

This major contribution aims to spur tomorrow's leaders' and teams' ability to create and integrate the latest knowledge and innovations into their practice.



In 2024–2025, the first instalment of \$450,000 made it possible to:

- Take the first steps on several projects related to the Foundation's major campaign, like the Centre for Excellence in Healthcare Simulation and Learning
- Create learning products to help the entire healthcare network
- Acquire educational equipment, including a high-fidelity childbirth simulator

In 2024–2025, we had 20,269 donors, including 4,358 first-time donors and 2,029 monthly donors.

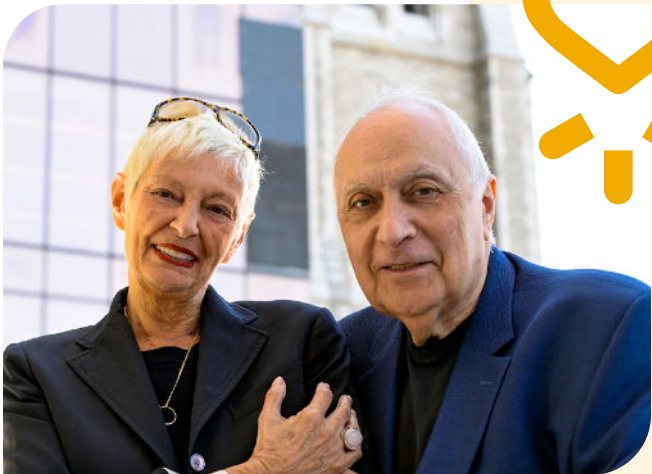

Leveraging robotics to act faster than disease: that's what Power Corporation of Canada's **\$2 million** donation to the Robotic Centre of Excellence will make possible. This pioneering project combines the CHUM teams' know-how with the power of artificial intelligence, digital infrastructure, robotics and other emerging technologies.

Power Corporation's support will help build CHUM teams' technological and training capacities, advancing their ambitions to provide innovative, minimally invasive, ever-more accurate care.



Since 2016, this hotly anticipated draw has helped raise nearly **\$2.2 million** for the CHUM.



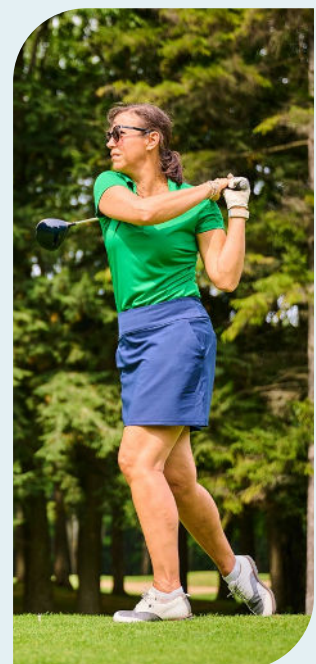

Emmanuelle gave birth to her daughter Alice at the CHUM, where she received personalized care for a pregnancy made especially complex by cauda equina syndrome, a disease that can cause paralysis and severe chronic pain. She is now living life to the fullest as a mother, having welcomed a second child, Graham—also born at the CHUM—to the family.

Carl's life as a family man was upended when, at 31, he had his first convulsive epileptic seizure at work. The cause was cavernous hemangioma, a vascular malformation he had no idea he had. At the CHUM, Carl underwent a delicate neurosurgery. Thanks to the CHUM's cutting-edge technology and multidisciplinary teamwork, the doctors were able to remove the mass that was causing his seizures.

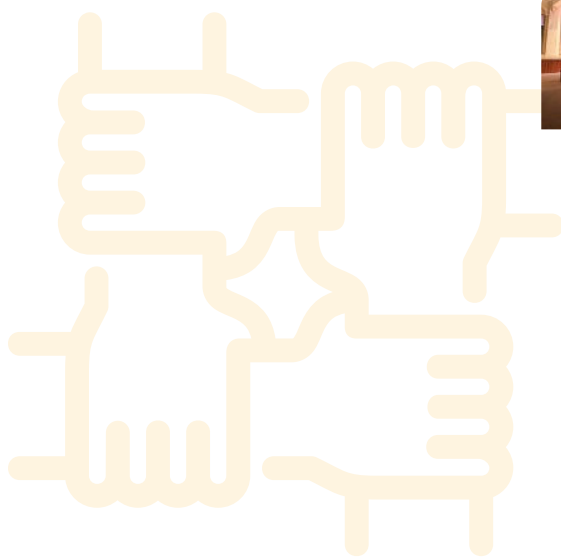
